

INDONESIAN BEGINNER 2

● Who should join this course?

The level would suit a traveller or a complete beginner who has no prior knowledge of the language. The student will start on all the basic fluency and proficiency skills: speaking, reading, listening and writing. The course aims provide the student with enough vocabulary and basic grammar rules to communicate with confidence in simple real life situations.

Week 7	Pergi menonton ke bioskop (Going to the cinema)
Week 8	Menjaga kesehatan (Maintaining health)
Week 9	Membahas politik (Discussing politics)
Week 10	Berkunjung ke Indonesia (Visiting Indonesia)

10 weeks, 2 hour session per week

Expected Outcome:

At the end of the course, the student will be able to say the following information in Indonesian:

- Able to use basic Indonesian verbs more fluently
- Able to use the right phrase when talking about transportation
- Able to use Indonesian conjunction
- Able to understand concepts such as 'ada' & 'yang'
- Able to use preposition of place
- Able to refer to other people's statement
- Able to express their own opinion in simple sentences

Please note:

- The enrolment fee must be paid at least one week in advance of the course commencement date.
