WHAT'S SPECIAL WITH THE COURSE?

- reading Vietnamese stories
- making polite requests
- describe an item and its quality
- reviewing classifiers
- building more complex sentence structure
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TUITION

Course Duration: 12 weeks, 1-hour and a half session per week

Course Fee: \$ 320 for standard 12-week class

Please note:

- The enrolment fee must be paid **at least** one week in advance of the course commencement date.
- All classes need a minimum of 5 students to go ahead. If your course does not have enough 5 students, it will be cancelled and you will be informed via SMS or E-mail. Alternatively, we may still offer the course for 4 students with a little bit higher tuition fee with your agreement.
- You'll need to dedicate approximately 2 to 3 hours per week outside of class time to your course, mostly to listen to the CD. You can do this at our school after or before class or any time at your convenience.
- If you would like to gain a better idea of our approach to teaching, you are more than welcome to sit in one of our current class of the same level (if there is one available).
