Expected Outcome:

By the end of this course students will be able to:

- pronounce korean character and memory the order of the character.
- be able to say hello, thanks, sorry, you'r welcome in different situation. And learn korean respectful courtesy through greeting
- learn vocabulary and be able to asking what this is using the vocabulary they have learned.
- be able to read numbers and ask and answer what time it is
- learn the name of korean food. Be able to order korean food at the korean restaurant.
- learn counting unit and korean money and be able to ask the price and buy things.
- be able to say 4 seasons, weather, 12 months, 7 days and ask the date, day, their birthday.
