Expected Outcome:

By the end of this course students will be able to:

- be able to introduce their family and ask about friend's family
- be able to explain the area where the students live
- be able to introduce their hobbies with friend
- be able to discuss what the students did on last weekend or holiday.
- be able to use past tense of sentence
- be able to make arrangements to meet at a particular place and time with a friend over the weekend
- be able to talk their daily and weekly routines
- be able to find a place in subway map in Seoul, Korea
- be able to discuss directions to a destination using a subway map
- be able to make a conversation when they buy a gift for their family or friends
- be able to ask the price and size of items
- be able to make a conversation on the phone
- be able to suggest something to a friend over the telephone
