By the end of this course students will be able to:

- pronounce all the sounds and tones in Vietnamese
- recognise the tones when listening to a Vietnamese word.
- say hello, goodbye,
- thank you and greetings
- describe himself, family
- ask for the price
- go shopping
- ask and answer location
- tell and listen to the time
- say numbers, weeks, months and years
- use modal verbs
- order food at a restaurant
