Comment from the Instructor

The candidate show several cases of grammatical errors in Subject-Verb Agreement and the use of preposition but these mistakes do not severely block the comprehension of the examiner. The candidate needs to improve her knowledge of sentence structure as she occasionally wrote sentences without any verb or subject.

The candidate should expand her vocabulary as many words are used repeatedly. Although the essay shows no major mistake, its coherence is not maintained because the candidate repeats her ideas in the Introduction. The linking between many sentences in the Introduction is also very poor.
